- Abstract Title: Maximum 20 words
- Abstract Text: Maximum 300 words
- Keywords: 3–5 keywords
- Abstracts must follow APA 7th Edition formatting and referencing guidelines

Note: Include the following details: Author(s) Name, Affiliation, Email ID, and Contact Number (WhatsApp).

Clearly mention the Corresponding Author. All author details must remain authentic and consistent throughout the conference for smooth communication

Paper Submission Guidelines

- The paper must be original, unpublished work
- The paper must not be under review at another conference or journal
- One paper may be submitted under one theme
- No change in paper title, abstract, or authorship will be accepted after submission
- Less than 10% plagiarism

Instructions for Paper Formatting

- Language: English (UK/USA)
- Font: Times New Roman
- Font Size: 12 (Text), 14 Bold (Headings)
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- Word Limit: 3000
- APA 7th Edition referencing style mandatory

Include Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Methodology, Findings, Discussion and Educational Implications, Limitations and Future Directions, Conclusion, and References

Note: Selected papers will be considered for publication in an edited book with ISBN
